It was serviced by Messenger Marine. The bill was itemised as follows (figures include VAT)-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* Service charge £100* Light Assembly £65* Vacuum Bag £33* Flares £22* Pills, Torch Batteries, Adhesive, Tapes, Cord etc. £40 <p>This seemed expensive, especially the Light Assembly.
