In order to wire in new equipment to a spare switch on my B36 fuse panel, I need special crimp/solder pins that fit into a white 12-way connector block. Behind the switch panel, there are two of these 12-way connector blocks, each in two parts, that link the supply wire to the load wire. Each block contains either 12 male or 12 female pins.

Does anyone know the manufacturer/part number/RS order code of these pins? I tried calling Opal, who said they could be obtained from RS, but couldn't give me a part number or description.

Sorry if this is already answered somewhere in the members section - I am now a member, but haven't yet received my login details.
